



CCCB Statement on the Persecution of Christians

Last week, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB), through the Commission for Justice and Peace, and in consultation with Aid to the Church in Need Canada, released a statement titled: In His Name: Statement on the Persecution of Christians (pdf). This was done in anticipation of Red Wednesday on November 20, 2019, which is a day of solidarity and prayer dedicated to raising awareness about the persecution of Christians throughout the world.



The statement outlines various types of persecution experienced and the reality of individuals and communities who suffer because of their faith in Christ, most notably in countries where Christians are in the minority. Understanding


that all Catholic faithful have a role to help alleviate the suffering of others, this statement offers possible suggestions of spiritual and material support for the millions of men, women and children for whom persecution is a daily reality.

Diaconal Ordination of Robert Elford November 22, 2019 Saint Mary's Cathedral Basilica 7:00pm


