





Mass for the Memorial of St. John of the Cross, Priest & Doctor

All are welcome to Saint Bede Catholic Community's next Mass, Saturday, December 14, 2019 at 11:00 am in St. Agnes Church, 6930 Mumford Rd., Halifax. All Catholics may receive the Blessed Sacrament. The Holy Mass will be celebrated according to Divine Worship: The Missal, the Vatican's new text for the celebration of Mass in Ordinariates around the world.

Saint Bede Catholic Community is a mission of the Personal Ordinariate of the Chair of St. Peter. This is a special type of diocese for former Anglicans in Canada and the U.S. who desire to be Catholic, but have felt a strong bond to their historical form of worship. Members of the Ordinariate are fully Roman Catholic, but retain elements of their liturgical heritage in their celebration of Mass.

We are privileged to have the musical presence of the Holy Heart Schola Cantorum and Mr. Greg Doyle, organist at St. Agnes, enriching the music for the Mass.

The Ordinariates were created by the Holy See in response to repeated requests from Anglican individuals and groups who had come to identify the Catholic Church as their home. The Ordinariate is a major step in the fulfillment of the Second Vatican Council's vision for Christian unity, in which diverse expressions of the one Faith are joined together in the one Church. 
